

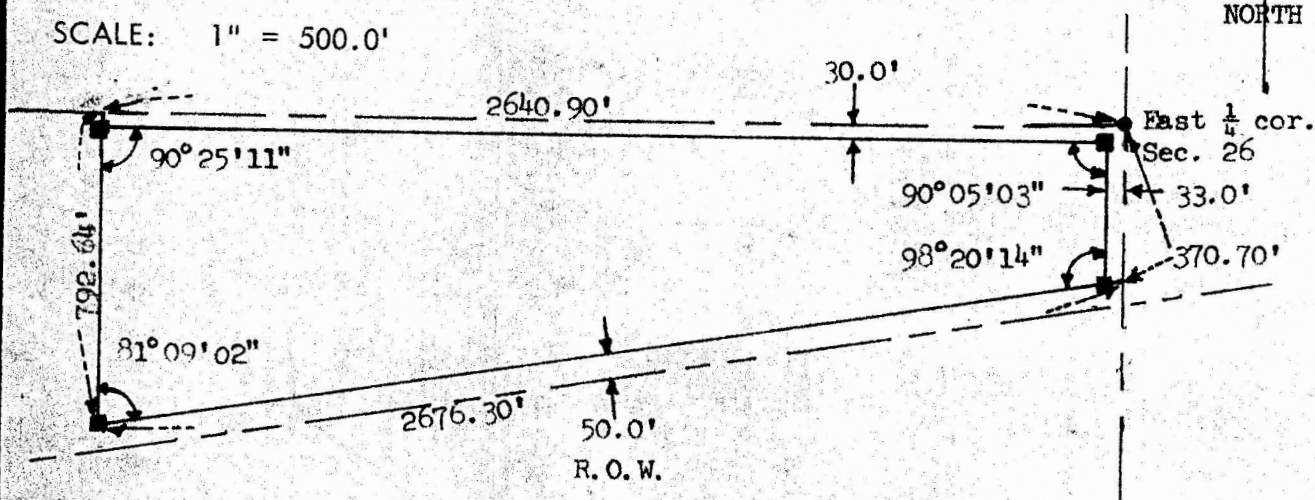
LEGEND

DESCRIPTION: That part of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Nineteen (19) South, Range Four (4) West, Sixth Principal Meridian lying North of the A.T.&S.F. Railroad, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the East Quarter (E/4) corner of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Nineteen (19) South, Range Four (4) West; thence South 370.70; thence West South-West 2676.30', along the North Right-of-Way of the A.T.&S.F. Railroad; thence North 792.64'; thence East 2640.90' to the point of beginning, containing 34.1 acres more or less exclusive of County road right-of-way.
