5.) Right-of-way Grant to Kaneb Pipe Line Company, dated September 10, 1953, filed October 20, 1953, recorded in Volume Misc. 115, Page 168, on over and across the SW 1/4 32-19S-3W, subject to lands taken for Highway No. 81 By-pass.

Partial Release of Rights of Way from Kaneb Pipe Line Company to Thorsten Johnson and Lenora Johnson, his wife, dated September 14, 1970, filed September 18, 1970, recorded in Volume Misc. 194, Page 111, releases right of way dated September 10, 1953, recorded in Volume Misc. 115, Page 168 (and other rights of way on other lands).

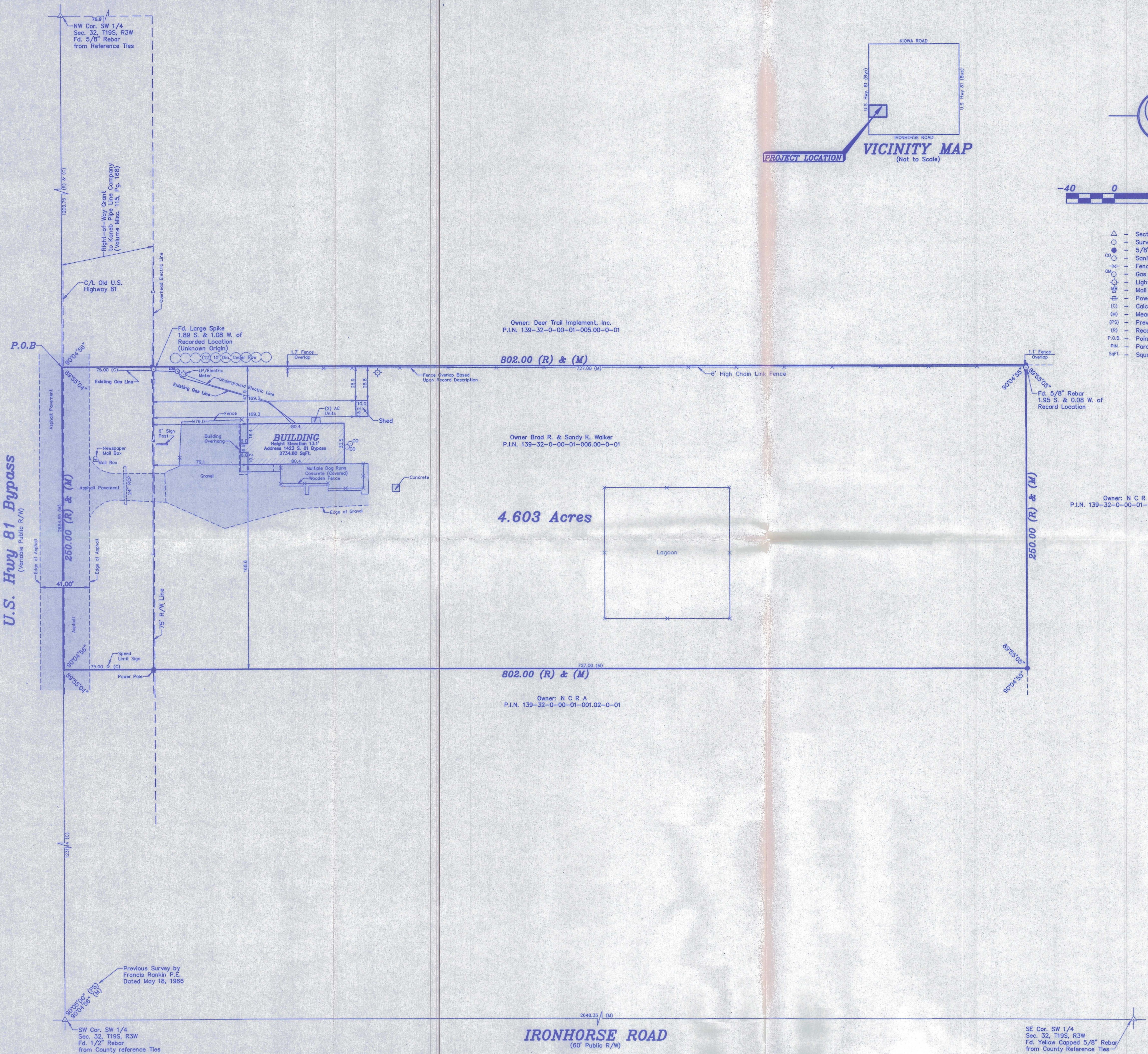
