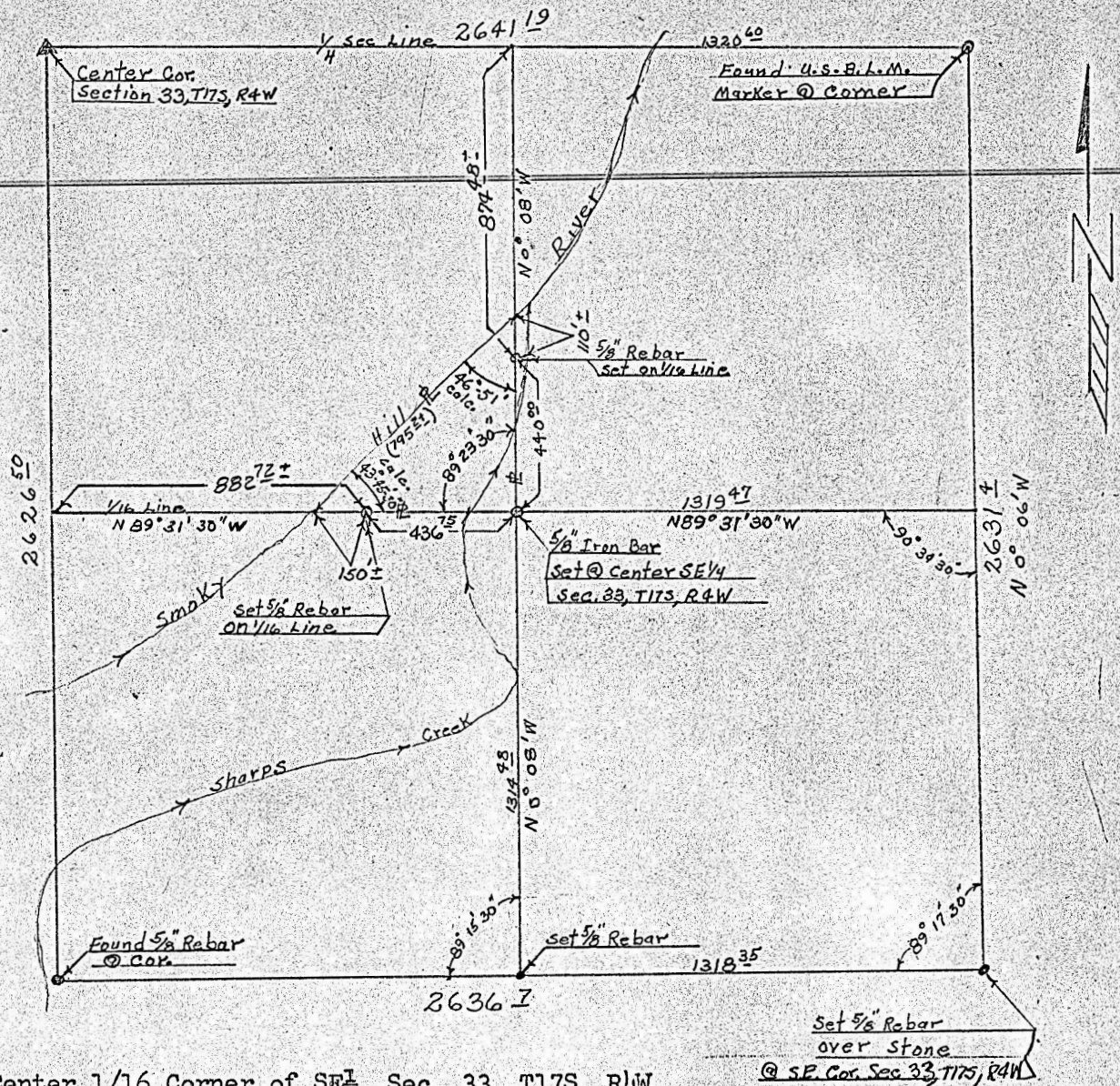

- 1: Spk & Wshr in 40" elm ----- 19.00 NNW
- 2: Spk & Wshr in 40" elm ----- 20.50 N.W.
- 3: SpK & Wshr in 50" Ash ----- 21.00 S. E.
- 4: 1.5 feet North of Old E-W Fence line

South 1/16 Corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 33, T17S, R1W.

- 1: Set 5/8" Rebar @ Cor. On line with Corners E&W.
- 2: Spk & Wshr in power pole ----- 30.42 E.N.E.
- 3: SpK & Wshr in top Guard Post ----- 50.00 E.
- 4: South End of 24" R.C.P. ----- 57.50 S.E.

S. E. Corner Section 33, T17S, R1E.

- 1: Set 5/8" Rebar (from U.S.B.L.M. Ref. Markers) @ Cor.
- 2: 3" Brass Disc on top 2" Pipe --- 31.9 N.W.
- 3: 3" Brass Disc on top 2" Pipe --- 32.7 N.E.

East 1/4 Cor. Sec 33, T17S, R1W

- 1: Found 3" Brass Disc on top of 2" Pipe set by U. S. Bureau of Land Management 1955, Marked 33:34
- 2: Old Cor. Post --- 1.0 N.
- 3: 30" Hackberry --- 5.0 N.

South $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor. Sec 33, T17S, R1W.

- 1: Found 5/8" Rebar @ Corner
- 2: In line with hedge to north
- 3: 1.0 N. of Edge of Mat.
