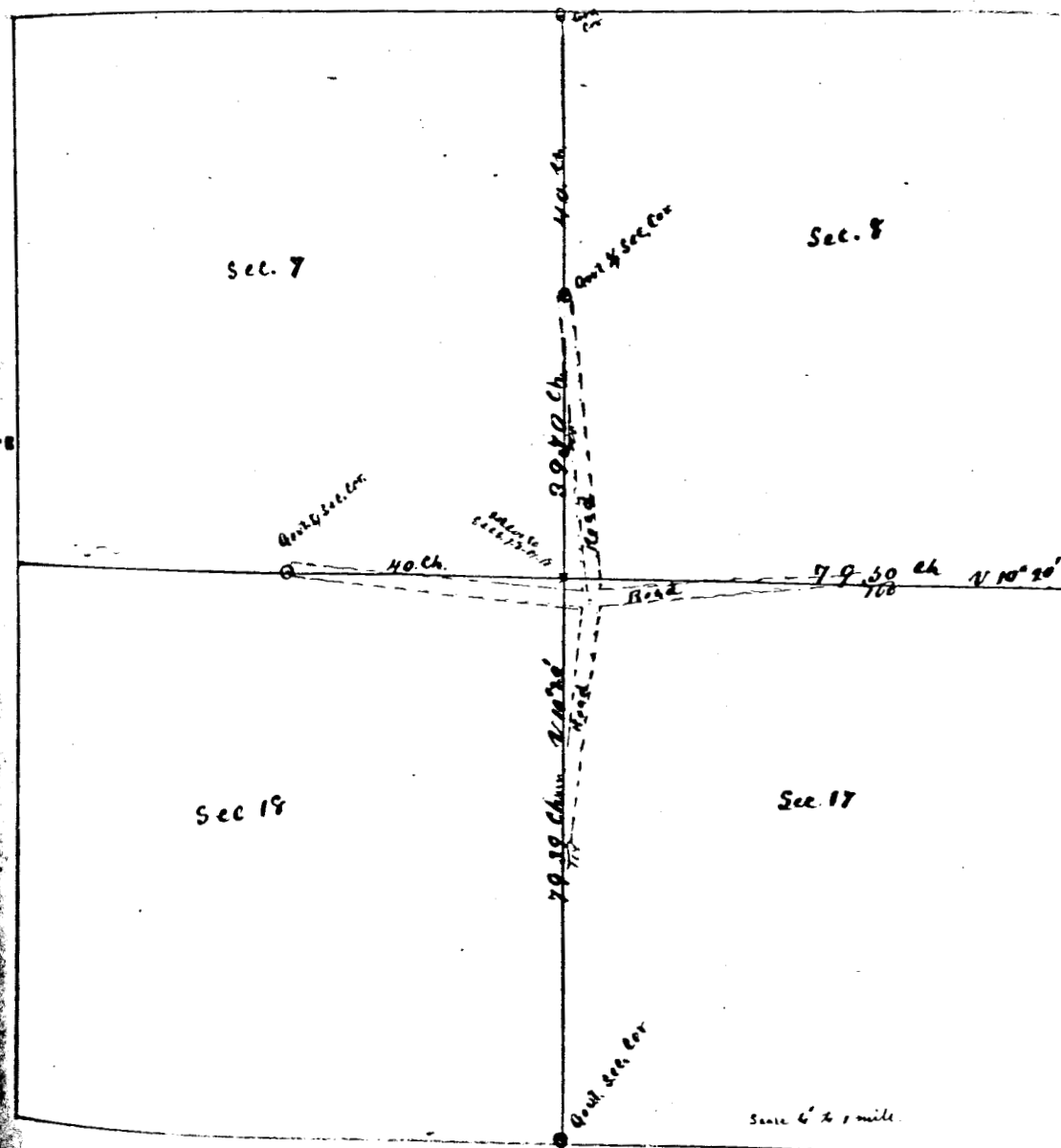

From the 1/4 Sec. cor. between Secs 7 & 18 T. 21 R. 3 W.
 East on sec. line N. 10° 20'
 set stone for temporary sec. cor.
 Found lost. stone for cor. to Secs 8, 9, 16, 17

From the 1/4 Sec. cor. between Secs 7 & 8
 South on sec. line N. 10° 20'
 set temporary sec. cor.
 Found lost. stone for cor. to Secs 18, 19, 20
 I then divided the distance proportionally and moved the temporary sec. cor. 30 chains North. and set sand stone for the permanent corner to Secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18
