

You are hereby notified that at 10 o'clock A.M. on the 3 day of June 1897, I will begin a Survey on Section 8 Town 21 South, Range 3 in which you are interested, and shall continue the same from day to day until completed, commencing at the S. W. corner of said section, I shall permanently establish the corners common to Secs 7, 8, 17, 18 of Town 21 Range 3 first of 4 PM.

Natives having been duly served on me by A. Vogt a land owner in Sec. 8-21-3 dated April 29, 1897 to make a survey and establish the corner to Secs 7, 8, 17 & 18 Town 21 A. 3. I served notice as per above on the interested parties and agreeable to said notice proceeded on the 3rd day of June 1897 to make said survey according to the following

Field Notes
From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between Secs 7 & 18 Town 21 R 3 W
East on sec. line N. $10^{\circ} 20'$
set stone for temporary sec. cor.
Found least. stone for cor. to Secs 8, 9, 16, 17

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. between Secs 7 & 8
South on sec. line N. $10^{\circ} 20'$
set temporary sec. cor.
Found least. stone for cor. to Secs 19, 18, 19, 20
I then divided the distance proportional and moved the temporary sec. cor. $\frac{30}{100}$ chains North. and set sand stone for the permanent corner to Secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18
