Report for Legal Description

Research of the records at the McPherson County Public Works Department and McPherson County Court House revealed the following information:

Roads: 4th street is 45.00 feet wide, 22.5 feet on each side of centerline street. Ross Street is 50 feet wide, 25 feet on each side of centerline street.

<u>Surveys:</u> References found at the McPherson County Public Works Vault. A boundary survey by Victor Clough, dated March 7, 1970. Boundary survey by Garber Surveying Service, dated February 1, 2017.

<u>Field prodedure:</u> I used the bearing between the southwest corner of the east one-half (1/2) of Lot 18, Hansons's Second Addition and the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Southwest One-quarter (1/4) of Section 24, T17S-R5W for my assumed bearing. I set 1/2" x 24" rebars and I.D. caps at the monuments I set. I used Topcon GRE-3 RTK kinematic, G.P.S. receivers for measuring the found and set monuments for this survey.
