DESCRIPTION OF RECORD:

The North half of the North half of the Southwest Quarter Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 2 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, McPherson County, Kansas.

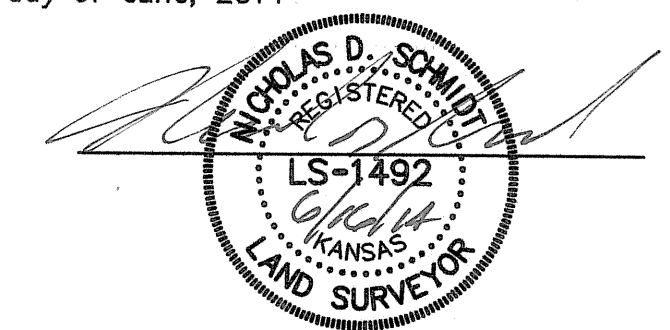
5/8" Rebar w/ GSS Red Cap near Southwest property corner
Elevation=1521.62 (NAVD 88)

SURVEYOR'S NOTES:

1. Searched for the pins set by F.R. Rankin in previous survey but did not find. It appears the existing fence and leaning fence corner was placed directly on the pin set at the SE corner of the property. That fence corner matches the distance to the found stone at the Center of section to the previous survey distance and is 1.12 feet West of a straight line from South 1/4 corner to the Center. Set monument on East face of leaning fence post for a measurable position.
2. Accepted the existing fence line as the South property line as surveyed and monumented in previous survey. Intersected surveyed fence line with the West line of the Southwest Quarter to establish Southwest property corner. The existing fence corner along the East side of the road way fell 26.20' East of the Southwest property corner which was within acceptable tolerances in comparison to the previous survey distance of the 25.0 feet.
3. Calculated a line from the Southwest section corner through the calculated Southwest property corner to search for a monument at the Northwest property corner (W 1/4 corner). Found a 60d nail 1.62 feet West of the calculated location. Accepted the monument and reset with a 5/8" rebar with GSS cap. Monument falls in line with fence line running West and in apparent centerline of travel way of 22nd Avenue which is 24.53 feet East of a straight line between Northwest and Southwest section corners as referenced on (PS2). This monument appears to be the best representation of the position referenced on previous survey by F.R. Ranking (PS1).
