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## Report of Survey

Research of the records of McPherson County revealed the G.L.O. surveys from October 1864 by Divania Furrow, platted September 19, 1865. Survey #40, November 12, 1900 by county surveyor H.A. Rowland. County road #319 topographic notes, field book #60, dating August 25,1933. Aerial photographs from 1938 and 1979.

## Field Procedure

A "60D" spike was found 0.4' below the surface at the intersection of Rainbow Rd. and county road 319 (18th Ave) from references that match with the physical evidence from the county topographic survey performed in August 1933. I accepted this as the location of the S.W. corner of section 6, Township 18 South, Range 2 West of the 6th P.M. I then searched for the W. 1/4 corner and the N.W. corner of section 6 finding no section corner monuments. I set the N.W. corner of section 6, Township 18 South, Range 2 West from references found from the county topographic survey performed in August 1933. I then measured the distance between the N.W. and S.W. corners of said section 6 from a point established on the section line, this distance measured 5287.79'. Using aerial photographs I then determined the location of the N.W. and S.W. corners of said section 6 to measure well with the physical evidence of a deep ravine bearing S.W. and Kentuck Creek described in the G.L.O. notes. Distances read with Sokkia Set 3 total station.
