Used township grader to search for stone in line of hedge and cultivated on East line of Section 2 and found no stone. Used County grader and searched fro stones at prorated distance (approx. 20' northerly of hedge) on east and west section line and found no stone.

Set East Quarter Corner per GLO prorating distances.

At center of section found two stones, the north being larger than the south, and placed a bar between both stones.

Advised County and Surveyor Timmesch of possible error in Timmisch setting a bar at West line "in line with the hedge row".
