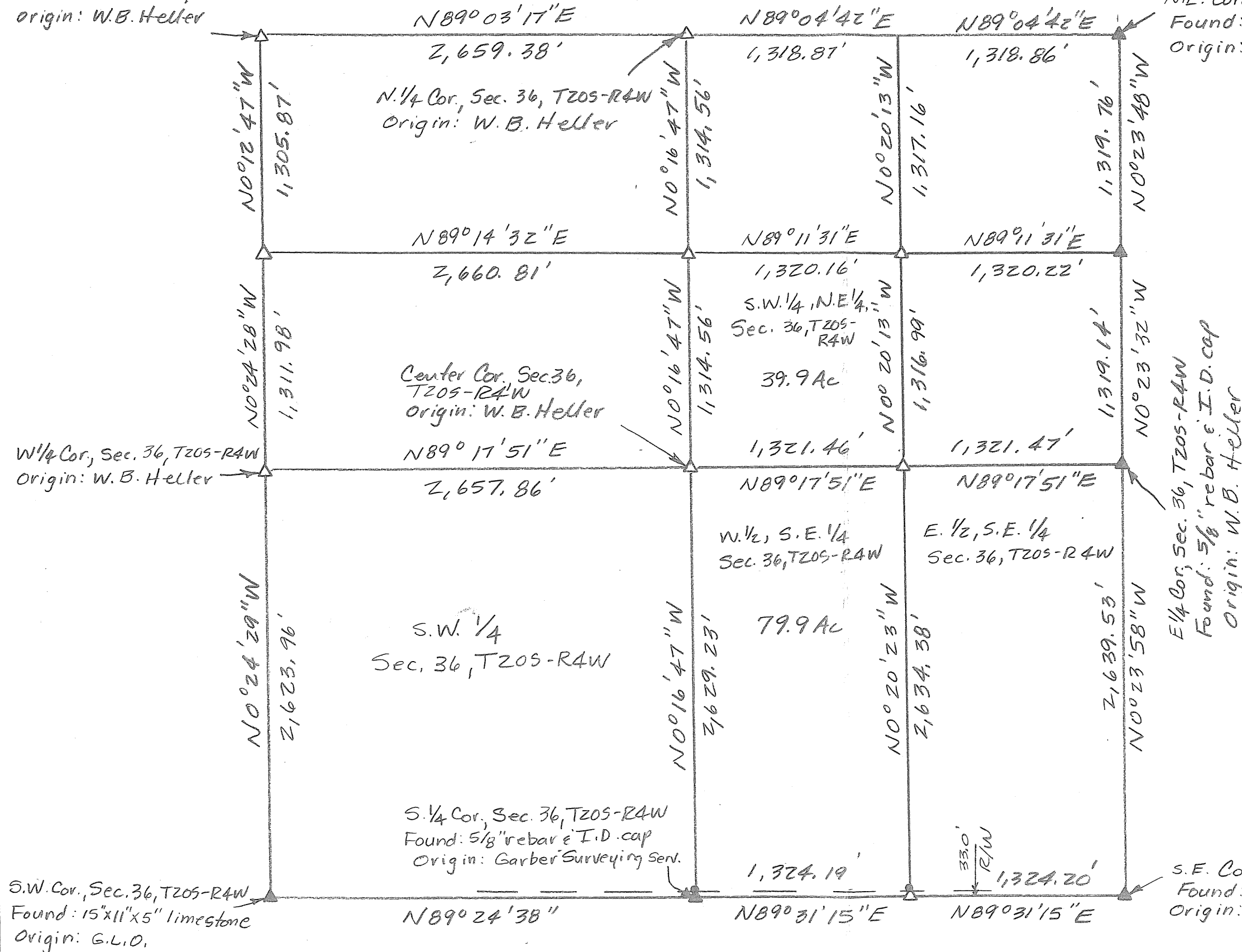

Report of Survey

Research of the records of McPherson County Courthouse and Public Works Office revealed the following information:

Surveys: G.L.O. subdivisions by Divania Furrow, dated July 23-28, 1866. Township lines by Divania Furrow dated October 1864. 4th Standard Parallel by Fredrick Hawn, dated October 1858. Section corner references found at the McPherson County Public Works Department Records Vault.

Road origins: Chisholm Road is 66 feet wide, 33 feet on the north side of the section line.

Field procedure: Distances and angles read with a DTM 521 Nikon Total Station. Static Ashtech G.P.S. Receivers used for location of survey positions.
