This is to certify and acknowledge that I, William B. Heller, a registered land surveyor in the County of McPherson, State of Kansas, surveyed the following:

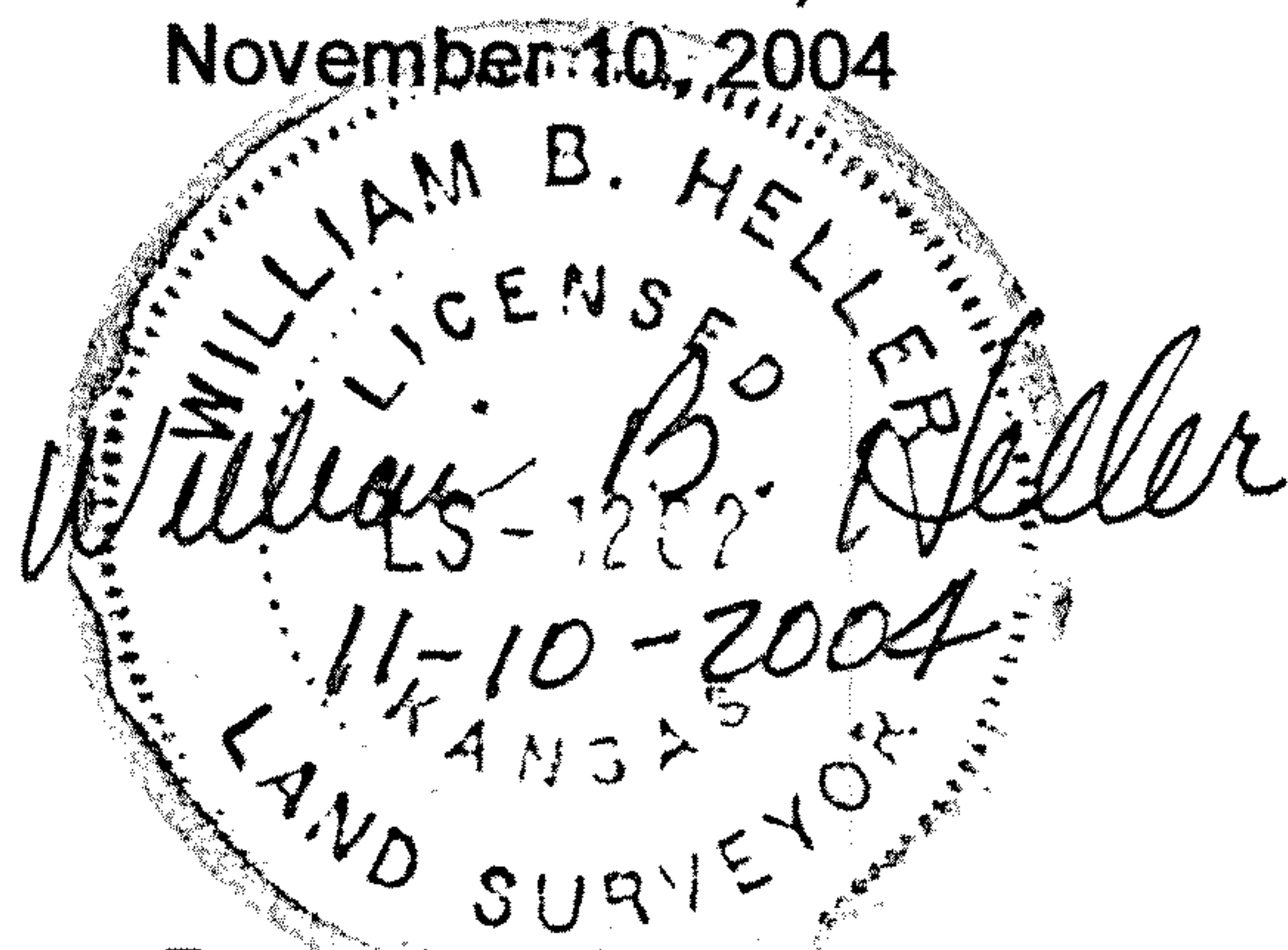
Legal Description:

A parcel in the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Eighteen (18) South, Range Five (5) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of said Section 13, T18S-R5W thence North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 74.73 feet along the North Section Line of said Section 13 to the point of beginning; thence continuing North 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West along the North Section Line of said Section 13, 732.69 feet; thence South 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 594.52 feet; thence South 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 732.69 feet; thence North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 594.52 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 10.0 acres including existing road right of way. Said parcel is subject to any easements or restrictions of record.

Report of Survey

Research of the records at the McPherson County Public works office revealed the following information:

Roads: Road right of way on the North side of section 13, T18S-R5W, 66 feet, 33 feet on each side of section line. This road right of way width originates from a State Statute passed in 1872 declaring all section lines public roads.

Surveys: References found at the McPherson County Public Works vault. I used the N.W. corner and the N. E. corners of Section 13, T18S-R5W for the basis of bearing and the North line of this property. The N. 1/4 corner of this section was not located.

Field Procedure: I used a Nikon DTM-522 total station to read distances and turn angles. I placed 1/2" x 24" rebars with plastic I.D. caps at the property pins I set.
