Report of Survey

Research of the records of McPherson County revealed the following information:

Roads: Road right of way on the West side of Section 28, T20S-R3W varies from 30.00 feet to 50.00 feet at this parcel. Road right of way on the West side of 2.4 acre parcel contains 0.2 acre. Road right of way information found in State Highway Commission plans for K-17 and McPherson County Public Works plans, Proj. 59C-3213-01, dated 1995.

Surveys: References for section corners found at the McPherson County Public Works vault. Permanent survey by H.A. Rowland, Co. Surveyor, dated April 11, 1902.

Field Procedure: I searched for the following monuments: The Southwest Corner, the West 1/4 Corner, the Northeast Corner, the East 1/4 Corner, and the Southeast corner, all in Section 28, T20S-R3W. I found all the section corners searched for of said section in good condition except the East 1/4 corner of said Section 28. All angles and distances read with a DTM-522 total station. I set the East 1/4 corner of Section 28 on line and 1/2 way at proportionate distance. Permanent survey #53 performed by H.A. Rowland, Co. Surveyor, dated April 11, 1902 was used for the retracement of said E. 1/4 corner.

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
