LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Two tracts of land all in the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 4, Township 20 South, Range 3 West of the 6th P.M. in McPherson County, Kansas, being more particularly described as follows:

The first tract beginning at the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$); thence Easterly along the South line of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) having an assumed control bearing of North 90° East for a distance of 660.83 feet; thence Northerly on a line parallel to the West line of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) having a bearing of North 01°13' East for a distance of 661.78 feet; thence Westerly along a line parallel to the South line of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) having a bearing of North 90° West for a distance of 660.83 feet to a point on said West line; thence Southerly on said West line having an assumed bearing of South 01°13' West for a distance of 661.78 feet to the point of beginning; said first tract containing 10.04 acres, less public road rights-of-way.

The second tract being described as follows: From the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$); thence Easterly along the South line of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) having an assumed control bearing of North 90° East for a distance of 660.83 feet to the point of beginning; thence Easterly along said South line having a bearing of North 90° East for a distance of 660.83 feet; thence Northerly along a line parallel to the West line of said Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) having a bearing of North 01°13' East for a distance of 661.78 feet; thence Westerly along a line parallel to said South line, having a bearing of North 90° West for a distance of 660.83 feet; thence Southerly along a line parallel to said West line, having a bearing of South 01°13' West, for a distance of 661.78 feet to the point of beginning; said second tract containing 10.04 acres.
