

On January 7, 1978, I made a survey of a tract of land described as follows:

Commencing at a point One Thousand Five Hundred Eighty feet (1580') West and North on a 90°00' angle for a distance of Two Hundred Twenty Five feet (225') from the Southeast Corner of Section Four (4), Township Twenty (20) South, Range Four (4) West, McPherson County, Kansas for a place of beginning and running thence South 87°00' West, Ninety Four feet (94'); thence West 74°29' North, Fifty Seven feet (57'); thence North 90°00' West, One Hundred Five feet (105'); thence East 90°00' North, Two Hundred Ninety Seven feet (297'); thence South 90°00' East, Two Hundred Fourteen feet (214'); thence West 90°00' South, Three Hundred Forty Seven feet (347') to the place of beginning and containing One and Fifty Eight Acres (1.58) more or less.
