Report of Survey

Research of the records of McPherson County revealed the following information:

Roads: Road on the North side of section 21, T21S-R4W, 33.00' on each side of section line. Road right of way area on the North side of parcel computes to be 0.2 acre.

<u>Surveys:</u> Legal boundary survey by F.R. Rankin, of a parcel in the Northwest quarter of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 4 West of the 6th P.M., dated April 1, 1968. Legal boundary survey by F.R. Rankin, of a parcel in the Northwest quarter of said section 21, dated November 21, 1969. Legal boundary survey by F.R. Rankin, of a parcel in the Northeast quarter of said section 21, dated April 5, 1965. References for section corners found at the McPherson County Public Works vault.

<u>Field Procedure:</u> I searched for the following monuments: The North 1/4 Corner and the Northeast Corner of section 21, T21S-R4W and found them in good condition. I used a Nikon DTM-420 total station to read distances and turn angles. I set 1/2"x 24" rebars with I.D. caps at the property pins I monumented.
