

IN SEPT., 2001, I, KIM HUXMAN, PERFORMED A SURVEY TO ESTABLISH THE SOUTH LINE OF SEC. 33-20-4 AND THE NORTH LINE OF SEC. 3-21-4. FOR THE NE. CORNER OF SEC. 3, I ACCEPTED A $\frac{1}{2}$ " IRON BAR FOUND AND RECORDED BY BILL HELLER, McPHERSON CO. SURVEYOR, DATED MARCH 1, 2002. I HAVE SINCE DISCUSSED THIS NE COR SEC 3 POSITION WITH BILL HELLER, AND WE AGREE THIS CORNER POSITION IS IN ERROR AND SHOULD BE RESET FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

THE FOUND IRON FOUND WE AGREE IS FROM RECORDED SURVEY BY MELVIN FERGERTSON, P.E., DATED MAY, 1974. MR. FERGERTSON DOES NOT STATE HOW OR THE METHOD USED TO SET THIS CORNER.

THIS CORNER POSITION (THE FOUND IRON BAR) IS 3.06 Ft SOUTH OF THE STANDARD PARALLEL. I RESET THE N.E. CORNER OF SECTION 3-T215-R4W AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE STANDARD PARALLEL (BETWEEN S.W. COR 35-20-4 AND S $\frac{1}{4}$ COR 35-20-4) AND A LINE PRODUCED NORTH FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ COR SEC 3 THROUGH THE SE. COR. NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SEC. 3. THIS RESET POSITION FITS DISTANCES TO RECORDED SURVEY BY A. BASS, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN JUNE, 1887 AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) NORTH LINE OF NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SEC 3 = 1887 (2638.69 Ft) - MEAS = 2638.59
- 2) EAST LINE OF NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SEC 3 = 1887 (1203.18) - MEAS = 1204.58

MR. BILL HELLER, COUNTY SURVEYOR, AGREES WITH THIS RESET POSITION, AND TIES TO EARLIER FOUND BAR ARE SHOWN.

For example: The southwest corner of Section 26 would be designated by the identifier 17V. (this is the LOCATION CODE OF MARKER IN TOWNSHIP to be entered in the three boxes on the front side of this sheet).
