
This is to certify and acknowledge that I, William B. Heller, a registered land surveyor in the County of McPherson, State of Kansas, surveyed the following:

Said parcel contains 35.25 acres including existing road right of way and any other easements of record.

Report of Survey

Research of the records of McPherson County revealed the following information:

Roads: Road right of way on the south side of Section 12, T21S-R5W, 66 feet, 33 feet on each side of Section Line. Parcel contains 0.4 acre of public road right of way on the south side of parcel. The public road right of way on the south side of said Section 12 was established by State Statute in 1872.

<u>Surveys:</u> References for section corners found at the McPherson County Public Works vault.

<u>Field Procedure:</u> I found the S.W. corner, W. 1/4 corner, Center corner and S. 1/4 corner corner of section 12, T21S-R5W in good condition. I laid the parcel out parallel to the N.-S. 1/4 section line on the flagged position on the southwest side of the parcel. I set 1/2" x 24" rebar with plastic I.D. caps at the property positions I monumented. All distances and angles read with a 522 Nikon Total Station.
